Health-Allergies & infectious diseases

REMINDER WE ARE AN ALLERGY AWARE CENTRE.

A Polite reminder that we have children who have SEVERE allergies within our Centre, we are a **NUT and EGG** aware centre, any items that contain these items within a child's packed lunch box will be sent home with a reminder note of why the food is unsuitable.

We would also like to highlight that we are a health promoting centre at Oakburn and again will monitor the sugar content of children's lunches and send home if not suitable whilst at nursery. If you would like to be reminded of these hidden sugar foods please ask Lyndsay in our office to give you a copy of our healthy packed lunch leaflet or this can be emailed out to you. This was also in the welcome packs given when each child starts with us at Oakburn.

Absent Policy

We have an absent management policy in place to ensure the safety of your children. Please continue to inform the office at your earliest convenience if your child will not be in attendance.

COVID-19

Due to current Covid-19 guidance, if your child displays symptoms—new continuous cough, high temperature, loss of taste or smell, your child <u>must not attend</u> and should book a PCR. Staff within the centre will also follow this guidance.

As per guidance, if there is a positive covid case within a household—children under 5 can still attend nursery (unless positive themselves or showing symptoms) We kindly request that any adult/parent/guardian who is dropping off/collecting the child at this time adheres to isolation guidance and refrains from entering the building if confirmed as positive themselves. This is to ensure all children, staff and families are kept safe. We thank you for your continued cooperation on this.

Allocation news

Applications for academic year August 2022– July 2023 close end of day 28th February 2022. Any applications received after 28th February 2022 will be classed as a late application and your space is not guaranteed.

<u>Returning 3 & 4 year olds</u> - Any returning 3/4s (who's DOB falls between March 2018—February 2019) - do not need to re apply again.

However, If you wish for your child/children's pattern to change you will have to complete an alteration form to change the pattern.

<u>New 3 & 4 year olds</u> - This includes any child who's DOB falls between **March 2019—July 2019** and any 2 year old who turns 3 between **August 2022 - July 2023** should now have applied for your 3 year old place.
