## Lunches

#### 2021-2022 Funding For School Leavers

Reminder- All funding for any children going to school in August 2022 ends on 31st July (as stated in nursery contract). Early years have asked that any parent who wishes to have additional days in August until school start date, to complete an alteration request form which can be found on the EDC website.

These additional hours will not be invoiced until <u>August</u>. Full hours would be charged at the hourly rate which is currently £4.68, however this is may increase in August. Early Years have requested at least 4 weeks notice for this alteration for billing purposes. **Please see**Nursery office if you require additional days in August to inform centre of finishing dates.

### Pre School Eye Screening

The optician will be coming to Oakburn on <u>Wednesday 15th June from 9am</u> for all pre school visual screening. Permission for visual screening is part of your child's care plan which is completed when your child starts at Oakburn. If you would like to opt out of the visual screening please speak to the office.

If your child does not attend this day and is a pre school child (children going to school in August 2022) Please see the office to pick a time slot for your child to attend for this appointment.
