#### Communication Station

Staff have created a communication area at the main gate, where parents are encouraged to come into the nursery at all drop off and pick up times to sign their child in and out. A staff member will always be available in the area during busier times to support parents/carers. During our busiest time of 12:30-12:45, we ask parents to wait at this area and a member of staff will support your child to gather their belongings and guide them to you.

### Community Links

Our Community Link Leader, Leonie has organised monthly trips to a local Care Home, Milngavie Manor Care Home. Children, staff and residents are improving wellbeing, developing social skills and their communication.

On each visit 8 children will be attending, four from our 2-3 room and 4 from our 3-5 room. We will aim to allow as many children to have this amazing opportunity, however this will be dependent on the day of the visit as these are not consistently on a set day of the week.

For us to continue to take part in community and wider visits, please ensure you have completed the EV3 permission form to allow your child to participate in these experiences.

## Personal belongings

All children have been given an individual smart sack, blue for 2-3 room and green for 3-5 room. This means you are not required to bring any other bags to nursery.

We provide these bags to reduce the amount of items on children's pegs.

We kindly ask that you fill the smart sacks with extra clothes and shoes and clearly label them with your child's name.

### Treat Fund

At Oakburn we kindly ask that parents contribute to our treat fund, £2 per week

Uniform orders will be placed at the end of each month.

## Nursery Session Times/Alterations

As our new term begins, there may have been some changes to your child's sessions. Please find below a reminder of the nursery session times:

AM 8:00-12:45, PM 1:15-6:00, Full Day 8:00-5:30/ 8:00-5:00/ 8:00-6:00

If you are unsure of your child's session times please check with the Office.

It is important for <u>all parents/carers to collect their child on time</u> as late collections impact staff ratio at busy times. If you would like any daily feedback about your child, please allow time for this before collecting at the end of your child's session for staff to be able to give this.

Reminder: Any alterations to your child's sessions can only be submitted ONCE per term and 4 weeks notice should be given for this change. There are 3 terms in a year running from August-December, January—March, April—July. Please speak to the office regarding any changes and availability. Alteration forms can be found on the EDC website.

## Toys from home

We recommend that children <u>do not</u> bring toys from home to nursery. This is to prevent any toys becoming lost or broken. If your child requires a comforter from home please ensure <u>that their name is on this.</u>
