Sun Awareness

As the nicer weather is coming, we kindly ask that your children come to nursery dressed appropriately. We recommend that children have a **sun hat and sunglasses** for sunny days. Please ensure your child's name are on these items.

We ask that children come to nursery with suncream already applied or that you use the nursery suncream on arrival. Staff members check the UV rate daily and suncream must be applied if the <u>UV rate is 3 or above</u> even if it is not sunny.

If your child requires <u>specific</u> suncream please provide the nursery with a bottle with their name on it. <u>It is recommended that suncream is</u> <u>factor 50, UVA and UVB protected.</u>

All suncream provided last year has been disposed of as we can only hold the cream for a year once it has been opened.

Personal belongings

All children have been given an individual smart sack, **blue for 2-3** room and **green for 3-5** room. This means you are not required to bring any other bags to nursery.

We provide these bags to reduce the amount of items on children's pegs.

We kindly ask that you fill the smart sacks with extra clothes and shoes and clearly label them with your child's name.
