Gate Security

Parent Meetings

Settle Meetings

For any new children starting throughout the centre we arrange settle meetings with the parent approx. 6 weeks after starting. This is a general chat regarding the progress of a new nursery.

Focus Child

Throughout the academic year staff within the 3-5 Room will carry out Focus Child observations on their keyworker children. You will be informed of the week these will take place for your children.

This is an opportunity for keyworkers to work closely with their key children to identify their next steps in learning.

Once completed Keyworkers will arrange a parent meeting to discuss this in person and update any important information about your child.

At Oakburn we use this method for parent meetings to be scheduled throughout the year instead of formal Parents Evening once a year.

Car Park Safety

Our car park is busy with pedestrians and children at all times of the **day** and we cannot stress enough the importance of driving carefully. All parents/carers using the carpark **must slow down appropriately** before entering, in addition to driving at **5MPH** throughout the entire time you are within the carpark. We also ask that you remain vigilant at all times within the car park, as many children are using bikes, scooters, etc and with the form please let the office could suddenly appear on the road unexpectedly.

> Ensuring the safety of all children and families while using the car park is our priority and we thank you for your ongoing cooperation with this.

Can we also take this opportunity to remind everyone that the disabled car parking spaces are reserved for blue badge holders only. All other parents/carers must use the allocated spaces on the right-hand side of the car park.
