# Personal belongings

We kindly ask that children refrain from bringing in any toys to nursery to prevent them getting lost or broken.

## Sun Awareness

Finally the sun is beginning to shine!

During the months of April- July we apply suncream with the UV Level is at 3! We kindly ask that you supply suncream for your children with their name on it and that you have applied suncream at home before coming to nursery.

The recommended factor of suncream 50+ UVA and UVB protection is the best children. However, factor 30 is acceptable.

From researching we recommend the 8 hour suncream which is applied in the morning and lasts the full day. This is slightly more
